

CRITICAL FACTORS MAKING BREAST CANCER DEADLY

- UP TO 50% OF WOMEN HAVE DENSE BREASTS.
- MAMMOGRAPHY ALONE MISSES 50% OF BREAST CANCERS IN WOMEN WITH DENSE BREASTS.
- BREAST CANCER IS ALMOST 100% SURVIVABLE IF CAUGHT EARLY BUT IF IS CAUGHT LATE (STAGE 4), THEN A WOMAN HAS A 25% 5-YEAR SURVIVAL RATE.
- BLACK WOMEN HAVE A 40% HIGHER DEATH RATE FROM BREAST CANCER.
- BLACK WOMEN UNDER 50 HAVE DOUBLE THE MORTALITY RATE OF THEIR WHITE PEERS.
- ASIAN WOMEN HAVE LOWER RATES OF BREAST CANCER BUT RATES ARE HIGHER AMONG ASIAN AMERICANS.
- THOSE WHO SERVE IN THE MILITARY HAVE TWICE THE BREAST CANCER RATE OF THE GENERAL POPULATION.
